Where do I drop off and pick up my child each day?

How does check-in work on the first day?

The first day will take the longest as each child will receive a bracelet that they need to have on every day for camp. They will learn their group numbers, meet their counselors, and receive their camp t-shirt. They will also receive a small backpack with a name tag.

What is the daily schedule?

Although the schedule depends on the day's special outing, this is the basic schedule we follow for each day:

8:40-9:00am – Check in at the CMC 9:00 – Worship and Bible lesson 9:40 – Small Group and Snack 10:20 – Games and Crafts 11:15 – Lunch 11:45 – Load buses 12:00 – Arrive at the day's destination 2:30 – Load buses back to church 3:00 – Arrive at 3Crosses/Games 3:30 – Parent Pick up at the CMC

What should my child wear each day?

Your child should wear his/her Day Camp t-shirt (these are handed out on the first day of camp at check-in), shorts, sweatshirt, and closed toe tennis shoes.

Along with this, there are certain items they will need to bring with them for specific activities that will be specified on the calendar you receive.

Do I need to send my child with a lunch?

Your child will need to bring a packed lunch Monday through Thursday. On Friday ONLY a hot dog lunch will be provided.

What items does my child need to bring each day?

A water bottle with his/her name on it – label all clothing items as well. **Specific items will also be needed for water days – check the main schedule**

What are the memory verses for?

Each day, we encourage your child to memorize a verse from the Bible. If they can recite that verse to their leader on the morning of the specified day, they are entered into an awesome raffle – winners are announced at the end of each day.

What is the activity schedule for this year?

The dates are tentatively set as the following:

Monday – Oakland Zoo (wear good walking shoes, hat) Tuesday – Lost Worlds Wednesday – Rockin' Jump Thursday – Dye Wars/Ranch Day (bring light colored clothes for the dye wars) Friday – Aqua Adventure (come dressed in your swimsuit, shorts, and camp t-shirt – bring a towel and full change of clothes for after our time in the water)

How does childcare work after camp each day?

You must pre-register for childcare at \$20 per day per child. This begins right after camp ends each day at 3:30pm until 6:00pm.
