*“Peace be yours in abundance.” 1 Peter 1:3*

5 ways

**1. Claim \_\_\_\_\_ as your source of peace!**

*“The way of peace they do not know.” Romans 13:17*

*“Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.” Romans 5:1*

*“Peace to all of you who are in Christ.” 1 Peter 5:14*

*“For he himself is our peace.” Ephesians 2:14*

*“My peace I give to you.” John 14:27*

*“Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.” 1 Corinthians 1:3*

*“Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.” Matthew 11:28*

**“\_\_\_\_\_ Jesus, No peace, \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus, Know peace!”**

**2. Claim \_\_\_\_\_ as your pathway to peace!**
