## **Kids Camp FAQs:**

#### What age group is Kids Camp for?

Kids camp is created for kids entering 4<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> grade in the fall.

# Where is Kids Camp taking place?

We will be spending our time at Dream Mountain Christian Camp – 4952 Murphys Camp Road, Murphys, CA 95247.

# What is the cost of camp?

The cost for Camp is \$220 which includes housing, transportation, and everything that will take place during our time at Dream Mountain!

#### What if I can't afford camp for my child?

#### Will there be other groups at the camp?

We will be the only group at the camp and will not share access to the facilities with any other group during our stay.

#### How will the kids get to and from camp?

We will be leaving from 3Crosses on August 4<sup>th</sup> around 2pm and will take a bus up to Dream Mountain. We will be returning by bus and should be back around 3pm. We will send out a text to each of you when we are 30 minutes away from church.

## Will my child need any extra spending money during camp?

There are some items for sale at the camp including t-shirts and hats. There will also be snacks for sale during free time. These items are optional, but your child will need \$10 for lunch on the way home.

#### What is the adult to child ratio?

We will have 1 adult at camp for every 4 children.

#### What is the daily schedule?

The basic structure for our two full days will look like this:

## What will my child need to bring to camp?

A detailed list will be sent out prior to camp, but here are the main items he or she will need:

- Bible (if you don't have one, let us know and we can make sure you have one)
- Pen and notebook
- Sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
- Flip flops or sandals
- Modest Clothing
- Tennis shoes
- Sweatshirt/jacket for cool nights
- Swimsuit: one piece for girls, no speedos for guys
- Towel
- Flashlight
- Camera (optional)
