## THE BIG IDEA:

When we talk about God providing, we often focus on the physical things, but God provides so much more in our lives. This week, we learned about the battle of Jericho and how God provided victory! Sometimes God asks us to follow Him into crazy situations that don't make sense, but we can always trust Him to provide the victory for us. He has a plan even we can't see it! Read Joshua 6:1-27 before starting the conversation.

1. What was the best part of your day?

2. What are you thankful for today?

3. What were the instructions given to the Israelites to defeat Jericho?

→ March around the city for 7 days, on the 7th day, they were to march around, blow trumpets, and shout!

4. Do you think Joshua could have knocked down the walls without God's help?

→ God provided the victory, Joshua simply had to trust Him.

5. Was anyone saved from the city?

→ Rahab and her family

6. Why do you think God provided victory for Joshua and his people?

7. God provides victory over sin and death for us. How did He do that?

→ By sending Jesus to die for our sins.
