- I. What was the best part of your day?
- 2. What are you thankful for today?
- 3. How did the disciples react when the children wanted to see Jesus?
- They quickly tried to turn the kids away.
- 4. How did Jesus respond when He saw this happen?
- He got mad and told the disciples to let the little children come to Him.
- 5. How has God blessed you in your life?

This past Sunday we learned about Jesus' great love for His children. In Mark 10:13-16, Jesus' disciples tried to turn the kids away, but Jesus wanted to bring them close and bless them. He sees great potential in children and used them as an example for adults in their great faith. It is also a reminder that Jesus loves everyone – it doesn't matter your age, your skills, your smarts, or what you've done. Let's show great love for others this season!
