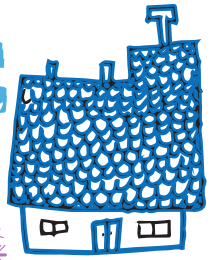


TABLE TALK

This past Sunday we learned about the Fall of Man in Genesis 3. This is the moment sin entered the world and the legacy of sin and death has impacted all who have ever lived. This story is a key reminder in our need for God's grace in our lives today. God has provided a way for forgiveness and salvation through Jesus and we should praise Him for that. Reread the passage together as a family and pray for your time as you dive into the story.

→ Anything we think, say, or do that separates us from God.

4. How did God show Adam and Eve mercy?

→ He let them live and gave mankind a chance to still be with God even though we sin.

5. If God wasn't merciful, how do you think the story of Adam and Eve could have ended?

6. Could you ever do enough to earn salvation?



7. How does Jesus' death and resurrection "reverse" the effects of the fall of man in Genesis 3?
