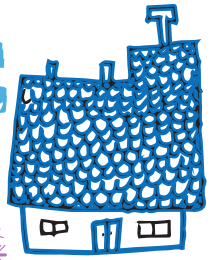


TABLE TALK

The Prodigal Son is an incredible display of God's grace. In the end, we are much like these two sons - many of us are rebellious and reject God while others think we can get it all by being "good people". Neither approach brings us closer to God in the end. Instead, we NEED His FREE grace and forgiveness - we could never earn it or deserve it. Reread the story of the Prodigal Son from Luke 15:11-31 as a family and work through these questions to discuss!

1. What was the best part of your day?
2. What are you thankful for today?
3. Who do the characters in the story represent?
→ Father = God, Son = Us
4. Did the son deserve a second chance?
→ no.
5. Does God give us a second chance when we sin?
→ yes!
6. Is there any sin that a person could commit that God would not forgive?
→ God gives grace to ALL



7. Since God is so gracious with us, how should we be towards others?
8. Can you share a time when someone showed you grace you didn't deserve?
9. What should our response be to such a gracious God? Since He is full of grace, should we keep on sinning?
→ We should respond by loving and following Jesus - sin destroys and harms us more than we think!
