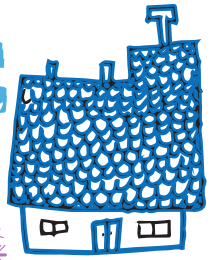


TABLE TALK

8. What did the Father do when the son returned home in the story of the Prodigal Son?
→ Forgave him and welcomed him home.
9. How did the King show grace to the servant in the unmerciful servant?
→ He forgave him and cancelled his debt.
10. How can you show God you're thankful for His grace?
