→ He prayed and said He was sorry to God
6. What are some ways we disobey God?
7. Why do you think Jonah ran away in the first place?
8. God sent Jesus to save people from their sins. How can you be a part of God's plan for Christians to further the kingdom of God?
→ Tell people about Jesus, love others, etc.

This week we dove into the story of Jonah and the Big Fish as we look at the truth that "God knows Best". Jonah disobeyed God and tries to run from God's plan, but God is patient with Jonah - even if Jonah didn't really deserve God's patience. The same is true for us: at times we try to run from God's plans and we disobey, but God is patient with us and truly knows what is best for our lives. Reread Jonah 1-3 as a family and then go through the questions together.
